3. What will be your priorities to reduce the health and safety risks from the climate emergency?
4. How will you support municipalities to make sure our property taxes are less impacted by the climate emergency extreme weather events?
5. Where will protecting the environment and addressing the climate crisis fall on your list of priorities once you take office? What will be the first steps you take to protect the environment?
6. What steps will you take to support the growth of the clean energy industry and create clean energy jobs?
7. Will you prioritize the expansion of clean, renewable energy sources, such as wind and solar, over the expansion of polluting fossil fuels such as oil, coal, and gas?
8. Will you support the restoration of the powers of the Conservation Authorities and the Ontario Energy Board?
9. Will you support cancelling the 413 and Bradford Bypass and invest that money in subsidizing the 407 for freight trucks and clean public transit?
10. Will you support stronger legislation to protect all wetlands, the food belt ( agricultural white belt lands) and prevent future Greenbelt highways? Does that include ruling out MZOs?
11. Will you restore and enhance protections for Ontario's species at risk?
12. Will you increase Indigenous-led conservation efforts and increase funding to nature-based solutions like stopping deforestation?
13. Will you support a review of aggregate mining practices to ensure the protection of our carbon sinks like fresh water systems, soil integrity, forests and wetlands?
14. Will you support funding and legislation to promote the electrification of school bus fleets?
15. How will you support greener building codes and cleaner, cheaper energy efficiency in new affordable housing?
